B.Arch. Degree Course

The candidate who have passed 10+2 or its equivalent examination with Mathematics as one of the subjects.

- (1) **OC** candidates should have secured not less than 50% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.
- (2) **BC / BCM / MBC & DNC / SC / SCA / ST** candidates should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.

(b) Diploma

The candidate who have passed 10+3 Diploma (any stream) recognized by Central / Stage Governments.

- (1) **OC** candidates should have secured not less than 50% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.
- (2) **BC / BCM / MBC & DNC / SC / SCA / ST** candidates should have secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.

(c) International Baccalaureate Diploma

The candidates who have passed International Baccalaureate Diploma after 10 years of schooling, with Mathematics as compulsory subject.

- (1) **OC** candidates should have secured not less than 50% marks in aggregate in all the semesters put together.
- (2) **BC / BCM / MBC & DNC / SC / SCA / ST** candidates should have secured not less than 45% marts in aggregate in all the semesters put together.
